

SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST Internship Program

Cumberland County Schools (CCS) District

- **★** We are NC's 5th largest school district
- **★** The largest city in our district is <u>Fayetteville</u>, <u>NC</u>. It is a 2-hour drive to NC coastal communities such as Wilmington and Oak Island, and is a 4-5 hour drive to mountain communities in NC such as Asheville and Boone
- **★** We serve approximately 50,000 students across 86 schools
- **★** Due to our close proximity to Fort Liberty (formerly Ft. Bragg), almost 30% of our students are military connected
- **★** We proudly serve students from diverse cultural backgrounds:
 - Our students speak 79 different native languages
 - Demographic profile: Black 45.64%, White 26.52%, Hispanic 15.85%, Two or More Ethnicities 9.09%, Asian 2.05%, Native American 1.34%, Hawaiian/Pacific Islander 0.51%

CCS Psychological Services Department

- **★** We currently have 26 full-time psychologists
 - Our psychologists are assigned 2-3 schools each
 - Our offices are centrally located at the Educational Resource Center,
 but many of us are also assigned an office or workspace by our schools
- **★** Our department is under the umbrella of Student Support Services (as opposed to the Exceptional Children's Program)
 - We participate in staff development and other collaborative opportunities along with our district's school counselors and school social workers
 - We also serve on building-level PLC's with the school counselor(s) and school social worker(s) that are assigned to that specific school
 - Our yearly evaluations are completed by our Director of Psychological Services instead of an administrator from the EC Program or a "payroll school"

CCS School Psychologist Internship Program

- **★** We offer a full-time, 10 month contract
- ★ This is an internship-to-hire program the vast majority of our interns stay on with us for several years after graduation!
- **★** Our interns are paid on NCDPI's salary schedule for Master's Level teachers (gross pay is currently \$40,700 across 10 months), plus a Signing Bonus
- ★ Interns are assigned no more than 2 schools
- ★ We will happily accommodate university program requirements for working with diverse age ranges and special populations, completing research projects, providing direct counseling & other intervention services, etc.
- ★ Interns meet face-to-face with their assigned supervisor at least 2 hours a week, but supervisors are available for additional consultation whenever needed
